

# STUDENT PARTICIPANT STARS UNITED GLOBAL OUTREACH YOUTH AMBASSADOR PROGRAM 2025 - 2026

#### Background

The Student Ambassadors are invited to participate in the program by administration because they have proven to be positive, responsible, respectful students.

Through the Youth Ambassador Program, youth gain the confidence to be advocates in their schools and communities. This includes grassroots advocacy through community mobilization and transformation, as well as advocating throughout the city of Dallas. Students will leave the program feeling empowered to create change in their community – no matter how big or small!

Youth Ambassadors will be expected to serve in leadership roles within their community. They may be called upon often to represent the program at conferences, media events, and other types of engagements throughout their term as a Youth Ambassador.

Members of the Youth Ambassador Program are hardworking and well-versed individuals who have demonstrated their commitment by reaching out to peers, friends, and younger students. Youth Ambassadors shall serve as role models for other students and agree to abstain from using drugs and alcohol.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

I am a currently enrolled student, with at least one semester of high school remaining at the end
of my term if I am a high school senior.
I will be between the ages of 12 and 18 years old at the start of my term
Be willing to attend one-hour weekly workshops in the Summer, Fall and Spring Terms
Demonstrate strong communication (written and verbal) and interpersonal skills
Exhibit leadership, initiative, dependability, discipline, and enthusiasm
All applicants must be students in good academic standing with no lower than a Caverage
overall and must agree to maintain that good standing throughout their term.
Members of the Youth Ambassador Program must be prepared to meet all the obligations
outlined in the "Roles, Responsibilities, and Time Commitments."
Students must be willing and able to attend trainings and events and must be accompanied by an
adult if under 18



### ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & REWARDS

#### **Student Ambassadors**

- Are positive
- Excel at communicating with others
- Provide excellent customer service
- Are open to learning new things
- Have a commitment to diversity and cultural pluralism
- Are a small group of students dedicated to the positive promotion of SUGO
- Will work on a volunteer basis to serve as liaisons between the current SUGO community and prospective students
- Be a helpful, friendly face for new students into our program and community events

#### Student Ambassadors may be asked to volunteer for events such as the following:

- Outreach events (feeding the homeless, food drives, special projects, etc)
- SUGO Open house
- North Texas Giving Day
- Events and programs throughout the year

#### Rewards

- Sharpen communication and public speaking skills
- Improve interpersonal and conversational skills
- Enhance confidence when speaking and interacting with many members of the SUGO community
- Develop networking skills through participation at exciting events
- Develop leadership to use in college and beyond
- Professional development
- Career entry skills
- College recommendation letter from SUGO
- Form relationships with community leaders, etc.

#### An ideal Youth Ambassador will be able to:

- Serve a one-year term
- Serve as youth representatives during our programs and events, on task forces, and on advisory committees (within an individual member's ability)
- Speak publicly about issues vital to the Youth Ambassadors

- Serve as a role model for Texas students setting an example of positive and responsible teen attitudes and behavior, including abstaining from using drugs and alcohol
- Be able to communicate effectively via email. (This will be the primary form of communication between the Youth Ambassador and the Project Director.) Be sure to list an email you check regularly on your application
- Join in scheduled Google Hangouts to discuss works in progress, current events, proposed campaigns, programs, and activities.
- Work collaboratively with all types of people
- Attend two Youth Ambassador trainings virtually

#### What is the cost of this program?

#### What are the criteria for selection?

Students will be evaluated on the following factors:

- a demonstrated interest in and commitment to volunteer and civic activities;
- ability to work cooperatively in diverse groups and tolerate the opinions of others;
- leadership potential;
- good social and communication skills;
- good academic performance;
- an energetic, positive attitude; and
- ability to implement projects that benefit the applicant's school and/or community.
